Chemistry Video Classes Terms and Conditions

- Classes are billed termly in advance, due just before the start of each term. Payment is taken via Stripe or a bank transfer with details on the invoice.
- Classes are non-refundable. Should you decide not to continue, you will lose access to the Google Classroom at the start of the following term, but you can of course save any resources that you wish to access.
- In the unusual event that I am unable to provide a scheduled class with resources, then the cost of the session will be credited towards the next term's fees.
- Self-marked consolidation work will be set following each class. Please do encourage your child to complete it, as it makes a significant difference to their progress.
- For those following the Video+ Course, this includes access to drop-in help sessions. Please note the timings are subject to change and I will advise of the timings at the start of each half term. There will always be at least two sessions a week available to increase ease of access. Should you be unable to attend a help session due to scheduling issues you are welcome to send me an email instead.
- For those following the Video+ Course, half termly assessments for marking must be submitted via the Google Classroom as a single pdf. I am unable to accept work via email. I will provide further instructions on how to do this.
- Access to resources including worksheets, assessments and videos should not be shared with anyone outside your household.
- The IGCSE Courses prepare students to take **Pearson Edexcel IGCSE Chemistry (4CH1)**.
- Parents are responsible for booking their own exams. As a Learning Partner with Tutors and Exams, parents are able to access a 15% discount on exam entry fees at the time of booking should you decide to enter through them. You will need to contact me for the code should you wish to take advantage of this.

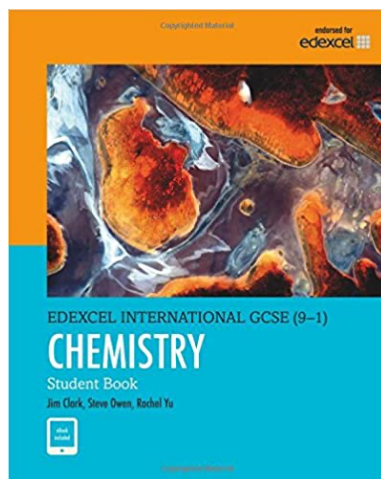
